PROTECTIVE FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED

On June 15, 2021, Governor Cuomo announced that New York has hit a 70% adult vaccination rate and that most COVID restricts were to be lifted immediately. The new guidelines are not intended for healthcare settings.

Due to this being a Healthcare Facility, our current safety guidelines have not changed, and we still require all individuals to wear masks inside all our facilities.

As more people are vaccinated for COVID-19, it is still extremely important to maintain safety measures to help prevent the spread of the coronavirus. These precautions include wearing a face mask, practicing physical distancing, and washing your hands frequently with soap and water or using hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.

Once again, all patients will be required to wear masks when they visit our facilities, even if they are fully vaccinated.
