## **Nutritional Support for the General Health of the Patient on Medication**

(2CE | Mary E. Balliett, DC, MSACN) When patients require medical intervention by the use of allopathic drugs, supplementation with the nutrients that are depleted may reduce the side effect of these drugs and allow patients the benefit of the drug, without these side effects. At the completion of this course the attendee will be able to: 1. List the nutrients depleted by commonly prescribed prescription and over the counter medication. 2. Recommended dietary changes and supplementation for patient general health.

## **Integrated Spine Care: A Guide for the Clinician**

(2CE | Douglas Taber BS, DC, CPT, DCP, DAASP, DAAPM) In this 2-hour lecture, we will discuss the role of chiropractic in an integrated care setting. We will cover evidence-based, patient centered care within large organizations. Emphasis will be on using our chiropractic diagnostic skill set and clinical prediction rules to determine care pathways to fully realize our role in the larger health-care arena.

## **NYS Workers' Compensation: How to Properly Evaluate, Treat, and Document**

(+2CE|2Cat1 | Alex Dell Esq & Robert Martin DC) During this presentation, you will receive an over-view of the current NYS WC MTGs for the back, neck, and non-acute pain. You will also learn how to challenge a carrier's denial of your MG-2and how to respond to a C8.1. You will also be given updates on the CMS 1500 initiative and the Chiro-practic Fee Schedule. A brief Q&A will follow the presentation.

## **How to Appeal a Medicare Denial of Payment and the Documentation to Prove It**

(1CE | 1Cat1 | Mariangela Penna DC) In this course, we will review the 5 different levels of Medicare appeals and learn when it is appropriate to initiate an appeal. We will review the use of the correct appeal forms, determine the order in which the appellant should proceed, and cover issues that should be addressed by the appeal. We will also dispel many long-standing myths related to Medical Necessity Determinations and prepare you with a plan—and the tools to effect that plan—so that you can accurately and effectively document your patient interactions to satisfy the needs of NGS and OIG.

## **Modernization and Your Practice: Proposed Updates to the NYS Chiropractic Scope**

(+1CE | 1Cat1 | Mariangela Penna DC) The Scope modernization bill was introduced to the NYS Legislature and has been referred to the Higher Education Committee as of Summer 2017. This presentation will cover a history of the 1963 Scope Bill and a review of the current NY Chiropractic Scope of Practice. We will discuss current trends in healthcare and reimbursement, along with how the current scope and the proposed modernized scope affects participation and integration into some of these systems. We will conclude with questions and comments from participants and stakeholders.
