NYSCA Focuses On Legislative Efforts



NYSCA Legislative Update

NYSCA is actively supporting A273 (Gottfried) S4640 (Rivera), which would require a practitioner treating a patient with a neuromusculoskeletal condition causing pain to discuss with the patient the efficacy of non-opioid conservative care treatments. These treatments include massage, chiropractic, physical therapy, and occupational therapy care. We are working in a coalition with the American Massage Therapy Association - New York Chapter, the New York Physical Therapy Association, and the New York State Occupational Therapy Association. We have seen great success so far as the bill has made it to the floor in both the Senate and Assembly. We are pushing now for a vote to be taken in each house and have had several meetings with both houses to advocate for this legislation. While we have been pushing for this bill to pass, we have encountered opposition from the Medical Society of the State of New York (MSSNY). MSSNY has issued a memo saying that they are opposed to this bill as it will create additional paperwork for providers. We feel that given the opioid crisis being faced in this country, a bit of additional paperwork for providers writing opioid prescriptions is not a burden. We will continue to work with the coalition to advocate for a vote on this bill.

As far as scope of practice legislation A4358/S1319, conversations continue as we discuss the necessity of scope reflecting our education and training, especially in light of the pandemic and the deficits we experienced here in NY. If you haven't already, please let your local legislator know how important this bill is and ask them to co-sponsor.

ACA Legislative Update

ACA held a virtual lobby day on May 6 with about 350 Doctors of Chiropractic and students participating, to advocate for HR 2654 the Chiropractic Modernization Act. The bill was reintroduced this year in late April with 16 original sponsors and as of May 12, 43 sponsors have signed on. While there is a long way to go, having the profession's support and enthusiasm is a necessary factor in getting movement on this bill. If you were not able to attend Advocacy Day any chiropractor can and should still show their support for H.R. 2654 by going to www.HR2654.org and send a message to their member of the U.S. House of Representatives. The site features a link that will automatically generate an email that you can customize and that will send the message directly to your representative with the click of a button.

I personally attended 14 meetings with representatives from around the state and along with Dr. Caitlin Simpson, our NY ACA alternate delegate and Dr. William Lauretti who leads NYCC SACA in advocacy efforts, and students from both NYCC and D'Youville and other ACA members, additional meetings were held. These meetings were mostly attended by legislative staffers and we are hopeful for many additional co-sponsors from NY as the 2 original sponsors are from our upstate region, Representatives Tom Reed and Brian Higgins.

I hope you will participate in continuing these advocacy efforts by sending a letter as described above to your representative or by scheduling a meeting (virtual or in person) with your representative. 

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
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














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ELECTION RESULTS





The Phases of Chiropractic Treatment

The stages of chiropractic care are unique, when compared with those of other health-care disciplines. Because chiropractic addresses core physiological and bio-mechanical aspects of the body, the process to correct problems without drugs or surgery can take time. Some conditions can be treated in a few visits, while others may take longer.

The following is a summary of the major phases of chiropractic care:

Acute Care

This phase of care is based on active injury with inflammation and pain. Your body is trying to start the healing process by increasing blood flow and activity at the injured site. Additional measures such as swelling, muscle tightness or spasm are your body's attempt to protect the area as it responds to the injury. This phase of your injury typically lasts for days to a few weeks, but it can be complicated by repetitive stress or reinjury. Treatment at this time is more frequent and is designed to reduce inflammation and pain.

Care at this time is frequent and can be daily to a few times per week.

Rehabilitative Care

In the weeks post injury, remodeling and repair of damaged tissue is the next phase in the healing process. This takes place with scarring and fibrosis of the injured area and is your body's effort to restore strength and function to the injured body part. In the case of joint injury, the damaged structures are primarily cartilage, ligament and sometimes, bone and muscle. Cartilage and ligament injuries are slower to repair and can take weeks to months to repair to their maximum degree.

Care at this time is typically less frequent and is reduced over time. Emphasis is placed on progressing through movement and exercise as the body heals and repairs from its injury.

Supportive Care

After an injury heals, there is sometimes weakness or vulnerability that results in periodic flare ups of pain and disability. This is due to loss of function in a joint, including loss of spacing or flexibility due to the residual damage to cartilage, discs and ligaments. During this type of care, periodic treatment is used to supplement the day to day exercises and interventions of the patient in gaining and maintaining health and functionality.

Care in this phase is quite variable and may be every few weeks or months, dependent on an individual's needs.

Maintenance Care

This is characterized by wellness! A person utilizing Maintenance Care has achieved optimal function and seeks to maintain a certain edge in overall health and performance. This type of care is often used by professional athletes and high performing individuals to assist in gaining a competitive edge, but the benefits can be used by anyone to assure optimal function.

Care in this phase is based on the individual's personal preference working with his or her Doctor of Chiropractic.

Increased arterial stiffness from mild Covid-19 infection.

Ontario Halts Astrazeneca 1st Dose Regimen

Citing the possible link of serious complications coming from blood clots, Canada's most populous province has stopped administering the Astrazeneca vaccine to it's residents. Citing the recent findings of eight more cases and an increase of alternatives, Ontario announced the change after many had been given the first dose and will continue with the second dose to complete their regimen. Canada has opted to follow a strategy of delaying second doses as long as four months in order to ensure that as many first doses as possible can be administered to Canadians.

New Guidelines for Physical Activity Issued

The WHO has issued new guidelines for activity in our increasingly sedentary world. It comes as no surprise to Chiropractors that maintaining fitness and activity are key components to overall health and not that the recommendations have been updated. Men and women between the ages of 18 and 64 should engage in 150 to 300 minutes of moderately intense activity per week or 75 to 150 minutes of vigorous aerobic exercise.

Children should engage in 60 minutes per day of moderate to vigorous activity.

Recommendations for those over 65 were less clear but we know that movement is a key component to good health, so keep that activity level up!

Lets look at the rule and make sure we understand what we need to do in order to be in compliance.

What are the Goals of the 21st Century Cures Act?

- Make Patient Data Requests Easy and Inexpensive
- Allow Patients, Doctors, and Health Care Systems to benefit from a vibrant application marketplace.
- Improve Patient Safety
- Prevent Information Blocking

Lets look as some situations you may face and see what you need to do.

If you have an existing contract, agreement or other arrangement that prohibits you from sharing data, then that agreement may put you into violation of the Information Blocking provisions of the 21st Century Cures Act.

What to do?

Review all of your contracts with your EHR and digital health vendors and make sure there are no provisions that conflict with the new rule. If you are not sure, please consult with an attorney.

What if you are not using Certified Health Information Technology (A Certified EHR).

The 21st Century Cures Act is not specific to any product. The rule applies to all information that you hold, whether it be in a Certified EHR, an EHR that is not certified, your billing system, your digital imaging system, or even word processing files. It is all subject to the rule.

What about paper records?

The 21st Century Cures Act is about electronic information. For details on Paper records you need to refer to the HIPAA Right of Access Rule.

Do you need to have your patient portal turned on?

This is an interesting question. The short answer is YES. But you do not have to have it turned on until you get a request for patient information through the portal. The moment you get such a request it needs to be turned on. If it takes 'too long' to turn on the portal and that results in a delay that the government believes it not reasonable you may be found to be in violation of the Cures Act. It is in your best interest make sure it is turned on now rather than having to scramble the moment you get your first request.

How quickly do I need to make lab results available through the portal?

You need to make lab results available as soon as you get them unless you can demonstrate that releasing the lab results may result in patient harm. This is one of the exceptions to the Cures Act. If you make such a determination, it is vital that you document this decision process so that you can defend yourself in an investigation.

What about "Draft Notes" and incomplete lab results?



The American Rescue Plan, which was signed into law on March 11, 2021, will lower health care costs by providing new and expanded financial assistance to New Yorkers enrolling in health insurance through NY State of Health. Our new fact sheet and website provide additional details.

This new, enhanced assistance is available to current enrollees and new enrollees, including to higher-income individuals for the first time if they qualify. Individuals with low and moderate incomes can access the higher tax credits now by visiting nystateof-health.ny.gov. In June, NY State of Health will automatically apply these higher tax credits to current enrollees without requiring any action by the consumer. Also starting in June, higher income New Yorkers can access the new tax credits.


Consumers who complete their updated enrollment in April will receive a premium invoice from their health plan that reflects the lowered premium amount beginning in May. To allow as many



Draft notes and lab results that are not finalized MAY not be appropriate to disclose or exchange due to the incomplete nature of the results. But if the information in the Draft note or incomplete lab result was used to make a medical decision then it must be disclosed.

Are there any exceptions to the Information Blocking provision of the Rule?

Yes there are eight (8) exceptions to the rule

Preventing Harm Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to engage in practices that are reasonable and necessary to prevent harm to a patient or another person, provided certain conditions are met.

Privacy Exception It will not be information blocking if an actor does not fulfill a request to access, exchange, or use EHI in order to protect an individual's privacy, provided certain conditions are met.

Security Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to interfere with the access, exchange, or use of EHI in order to protect the security of EHI, provided certain conditions are met.

Infeasibility Exception It will not be information blocking if an actor does not fulfill a request to access, exchange, or use EHI due to the infeasibility of the request, provided certain conditions are met.

Health IT Performance Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to take reasonable and necessary measures to make health IT temporarily unavailable or to degrade the health IT's performance for the benefit of the overall performance of the health IT, provided certain conditions are met.

Content and Manner Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to limit the content of its response to a request to access, exchange, or use EHI or the manner in which it fulfills a request to access, exchange, or use EHI, provided certain conditions are met.

Fees Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to charge fees, including fees that result in a reasonable profit margin, for accessing, exchanging, or using EHI, provided certain conditions are met.

Licensing Exception It will not be information blocking for an actor to license interoperability elements for EHI to be accessed, exchanged, or used, provided certain conditions are met.

consumers as possible to access these enhanced tax credits, and in light of the ongoing public health emergency, NY State of Health has extended its 2021 Open Enrollment Period for Qualified Health Plans through December 31. Ensuring access to affordable health coverage and care is more important than ever, so that individuals do not avoid seeking testing or medical care for fear of cost during the ongoing public health emergency.

Individuals who are eligible for other NY State of Health programs—Medicaid, Essential Plan and Child Health Plus—can enroll year-round. The best way for consumers to receive assistance at this time is to phone a navigator or other NY State of Health assistor for help. As always, they can call the NY State of Health Customer Service Center at 1-855-355-5777. By visiting our website, www.nystateofhealth.ny.gov individuals can find an enrollment assistor and get help over the phone. Assistors can also help with updating accounts if needed.

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COVID-19 Office Procedure Update

The pandemic has uprooted our routines and caused us to look at everything in a different way. Guidance continues to change as more understanding of the virus threat is discerned. Recently, members have asked about disinfecting and wearing masks in the office.

As of this time, face coverings are still required in patient care but there is current discussion of changing the rules as more people become fully vaccinated.

As of April 5th 2021, the CDC issued new guidance on cleaning and disinfecting. Initially, it was thought that there was a greater threat from surface contamination than we now know to be true. The current guidance reflects that knowledge and can be found in its entirety here Cleaning and Disinfecting Your Facility | CDC

Perhaps the most notable update is summarized below (from the CDC LINK). Use of soap and water is usually adequate for cleaning most surfaces, once per day.

If someone who is sick is in an area, that area should be disinfected before anyone else uses that area.

Routine Cleaning

Develop Your Plan

Determine What Needs to Be Cleaned

Consider the type of surface and how often the surface is touched. Generally, the more people who touch a surface, the higher the risk. Prioritize cleaning high-touch surfaces.

Determine How Often To Clean

- High-touch surfaces should be cleaned at least once a day.
- More frequent cleaning might be needed when the space is occupied by young children and others who may not consistently wear masks, wash hands, or cover coughs and sneezes.
- If the space is a high traffic area, or if certain conditions apply, you may choose to clean more frequently.

Determine If Regular Disinfection Is Needed

In most situations, regular cleaning (at least once a day) is enough to sufficiently remove virus that may be on surfaces. However, if certain conditions apply, you may choose to disinfect after cleaning.

Consider the Resources and Equipment Needed

Keep in mind the availability of cleaning products and the personal protective equipment (PPE) appropriate for cleaners and disinfectants (if needed). Please take a few minutes to look at the new information by clicking the link above and updating your office procedures accordingly.
